SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Newtown and District Auto Club will organise a Clubman's Production Car Autotest on Sunday 28th October 2018 at Newtown College. This event will be held on 100% tarmac surface.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Clubmans Permit (as applied for) will be on display on the day.
4. **Eligibility** - The Clubmans Production Car Autotest event is open to all fully elected members of the promoting club. Anyone who is not a member may apply for membership of Newtown and District Auto Club on the entry form giving membership until 31 December 2019. All drivers and passengers must produce a valid club membership card. A competition licence is NOT required for this event.
5. **Championships** - The Event is one of the next rounds of Newtown & District Automobile Club Ltd 2018 Clubman Autotest Championship.
6. **Programme** - Scrutineering will open at 08:30 hrs. Signing on opens at 08.30 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 09.45 hrs may be excluded. Drivers briefing at 09.45 hrs. First test starts at 10.00 hrs.
7. **Technical Requirements** - All cars must comply with the Road Traffic Act and the relevant MSA Technical Regulations. Cars must be currently registered (no trade plates), taxed, insured and where appropriate have a current MOT certificate, and be driven or trailed to the event. Proof of insurance and MOT certificate (or vehicle registration document for cars under 3 years old) must be available at scrutineering.
After Test 1, you will NOT be able to change your passenger.

8. **Classes** - The event will consist of two classes as follows:

- A - Front wheel Drive and
- B - Rear Wheel Drive.

9. **Awards** - No Competitor may win more than one award.

- 1st Overall Driver & Passenger
- 1st Front wheel Drive Driver & Passenger
- 1st Rear Wheel Drive Driver & Passenger
- Best 17 year old and under Driver & Passenger

10. **Entries** – Entries will be accepted on the day should the entry list not be full beforehand, however to Guarantee your place it would be best to enter before the event as it is capped at 30 entries, Entries will be open when these regulations are published and will close on the day of the event. Maximum entry for the event is 30. Minimum is 14. The entry fee is £25. All entries are to be made on the official Entry form and sent to Keith Jones, Grooms Garage, Unit 4, grooms Enterprise Park, Pool Road, Newtown, SY16 1DL.

11. **Officials** –

12. **Marking & Penalties** –

- Time taken completing the course = Actual time taken
- Striking a cone or barrier or any other course marker = 5 seconds per offence
- Failure to stop astride the stop line = 20 seconds
- Failure to stop at Giveways = 10 seconds per offence
- Taking an incorrect route on any course (Wrong Test) = Maximum Time
- Completing a test in a time exceeding the maximum - Maximum time slowest time in class for that course, plus 30 seconds. If a driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply.

13. **General** –

- Each driver will have two or more runs at each layout and all test times will count
- Timing will be by hand held stopwatches to the previous tenth of a second.
- Competitors will start in their own time upon clearance from the timekeeper.
- Timing will start when the front wheels cross the Timing line.
- Timing will stop when the front wheels stop astride the stop line.
- In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course, etc until the tie is resolved.
- To be classified as a finisher, competitors must start at least one run at all courses.
- Practicing will not be allowed.

- Any competitor performing handbrake turns or the like in the paddock and surrounding areas may be excluded from the event.
- All details of tests will be available when you have signed on.

14. **Identification** - Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers. And fitted to the Nearside Side window

15. **General Regulations** - The MSA General Regulations apply as written except for the following amendments:

- B78 - Judges of Fact: All officials, and competitors while acting as marshals, will be judges of fact for the purposes stated in D57.
- A43 - A vehicle may be entered three times, to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may drive more than one car.

16. **Results** - Will be posted immediately after the last car has finished the final test, followed by the presentation of the awards.
